From the Desk of Pastor Andi

September 2023

Do you ever have those days when you have so many things flying around in your head that you struggle to grab hold of one thing so you can deal with at least something? This time of the year it's always like that for me. The church year is ramping up after the summer. The school year is starting. The club soccer season is starting. There is so much expectation, so much information, and so much to do. Anxiety and stress can be constant companions when it feels like we are totally responsible for the success or failure of so much.

We are a people invested in the future. We want success for ourselves and those dear to us. Because of our desire for success, we tend to try to control. Control is an illusion. It is a house of cards we carefully built. When the winds come that destroy our precious creation, and those winds always come, we are devastated. Sometimes so much so that we cannot even pick up the pieces and start over.

Here is the bad news—you aren't really in control. You can do everything right, and still fail. We have experienced this and know the unfairness of it all. In the same way, we can make multiple mistakes and still succeed (we usually aren't all that outraged when this happens). Because we believe in our illusion of control, we struggle. We feel like we need to control not just our behavior and choices, but the behavior and choices of those around us as well. How difficult it is to wrap our heads around the fact that what is best for me is not always best for you.

But here is the good news—God IS in control. This doesn't free us from the responsibility of doing our part. We are still called to work hard and do our best, to pitch in when help is needed and know when to ask for help ourselves. We aren't given a free pass from trying, just a pass from feeling responsible for the success of the entire world. Because there is so much out of our control, our successes aren't all our doing.

The same holds true for our church. I have seen, over the years, people trying to recreate the church of years gone by. We remember the things we loved doing and want the same for the generations to follow—and this is good. But we forget that what was best for us isn't always what is needed for others. Like each of us, the church grows and changes. The passing of the years causes the church to look different, just as the passing of years causes us to look different.

Praise God from whom all blessings flow...when I hear these words, it makes me think of the song we sometimes sing at church. But as I write this article, these words came to mind after our July financial results were known.

Last month, I had noted that our financial year to date deficit had been a negative (\$26,289). July numbers were awesome where we saw a monthly positive cashflow of \$24,932 that resulted in us reducing our year-to-date deficit to a negative (\$1,357).

How fortunate we are to have had the opportunity to park cars at EAA and share in the revenue earned, resulting in us earning \$18,877.

Thank you to Jeff and Mary Ann Bartels for allowing us this opportunity and to the many members that stepped up to help with this work. Also thank you to the members of our congregation for giving a little extra to help with our financial needs when we really needed it.

While July was a wonderful month for us financially, we need to remain vigilant about keeping up our revenue and keeping our expenses in line as we move forward month to month. Thank you to all.



Church Council Meeting Minutes August 8, 2023

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: Blinds- - Quote from Tom's Custom blinds \$2660. Funds come from Memorial and Endowment Blind Fund, originally from Daughters of Sarah. Purchase approved. EAA parking was very successful, making a total of \$25,050, with \$18,787 of that going to the church. There is a Pizza Ranch fundraiser August 14th. Looking through the council terms, none are expiring the next election so all members who would like can run again.

Secretary's Report: Zach said there were some slight corrections in the minutes, which were adjusted. Minutes were accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed June financial reports. We had a negative cash flow of \$7,368.08 with a negative YTD of \$26,288.85. Alliant Energy stock was +\$1.02 (1.98%), in June, with a YTD of -\$2.73 (4.94%).

Majority of expenses for the month were Employees Pension & Andi's Health Insurance, Andi's Taxes, 2nd Qtr Fed & SS Taxes, WPS and Aware 3 (Website) Annual Fee. Reviewed July financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$24,932.10 with a negative YTD of \$1,356.75. Alliant Energy stock was +\$1.26 (2.40%), in July, with a YTD of -\$1.47 (2.66%). Majority of expenses for the month were Employees Pension & Andi's Health Insurance, Workers Comp/Church Insurance, OCWM, 2nd Qtr Fed & SS Taxes, WPS and 2nd Qtr State Taxes. Kim said EAA was a big boost for us, about \$10,000 more than last year, which helps a lot to balance the budget. Kim also mentioned to keep the sidewalk replacements in mind, as that will be a big expense coming up soon. Treasurer's Report was accepted.

Church Council Meeting Minutes

August 8, 2023

(CONTINUED)

Pastor's Report: General: Staffing Sunday School continues to be an issue. With Rachel Dehne out, we are in a tough spot. I had hoped to step back from teaching a class but that does not seem possible if we want to have classes for all the kids. We were contacted by Fox Cities Magazine about putting an ad in their Faith and Worship section of their "This is Oshkosh" city guide. Cost is \$195. Kim Henning would like to come speak to the council in January about the conference Capital Fund Campaign. I have begun to actively consider a sabbatical. Last Month: I have had 2 funerals since our last meeting, Ron Gafner on June 23 and Clarence Freiberg on July 29. I also officiated an interment for Wendy Baehman (funeral was January 14) on July 15. I had a wedding on June 24 for Evan Lehman and Ashley Hirte. This Month: We have a baptism August 13 for Reid Muelemans, son of Mike and Brittany (Conger) Muelemans (I did their marriage ceremony in 2018.) I am requesting vacation August 18-24. Karen Darnick, who has gone through Lay Academy, will be preaching Sunday.

Trustee's Report: Craig sprayed weeds. Tom is asking for the sanctuary and narthex doors to stay closed in order to keep the air conditioning where it needs to be. Leanne asked that people periodically check the dehumidifier we have downstairs, emptying it when possible. Trustees are also looking at hooking it up to a drain downstairs. Jim asked about keeping the fridge downstairs off, since we don't use it much. The council agreed that, once fully emptied, we can look at keeping it off as long as it turns back on easily in case it needs to be used, which it looks like it will.

Old Business: Financial Reconciliation/Internal Audit - No update. Sidewalks have started being replaced, but the bill isn't expected until late this year, so no further updates.

New Business: For the doors being locked during the day, currently the plan is for Lori to have a sign in order to call when someone is stopping by if she is alone, so she can walk down and open the doors for them. Any other (hopefully cheap/free) ideas can be brought forward, but this is the best course the council believes at this time. Kwik Trip has car wash cards that can be used for fundraising. It's for 5 of the Ultimate car washes, and we would be able to sell them for probably around \$40 (about 20% cheaper than 5 car washes) per card. Phone system - No update, the council agreed to keep using it until we can't then look into it further down the line.

Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

On behalf of Emmanuel's Church Council, I am writing to all members, friends, and supporters of Emmanuel United Church of Christ. I would like to make you aware of a couple fundraisers we as a Council have decided to try.

- **Kwik Trip Car wash cards** We will be trying this as a presale during late September October. The sign up will be available to you on the Raiseright table. You may also contact Lori in the office to sign up for it. Payment will be due at the time of sign up. Cards will be 5 Ultimate car washes for \$40. They can be used at any Kwik Trip/Kwik Star car wash. The profit to the church will be \$20 per card. This is a huge profit in our fundraiser standards. The cards will be ordered and available within a few days after the sign-up ends. We are looking to run this this through late October with card delivery by November 1st. You can get an early start on some stocking stuffers or holiday gift ideas!
- **Firehouse Subs dine out night** Monday, October 9th we will be at Firehouse Subs for another dine out opportunity with proceeds coming to Emmanuel for the event. Details for this will be coming soon, make sure to mark your calendars when details become available.
- **Sidewalk square purchase** We are looking at different ways for people to donate to the sidewalk replacement debt we are facing this year. Those interested in purchasing a square of the sidewalk or apron approach, the cost of the typical 5'x5' 4" squares are approximately \$300 and the 6" squares are \$330.
- More information will be coming in the coming weeks as we look for ways to fund the debt we are incurring from the replacement. The actual figures for the final cost are not available until the work is completed by the city and we receive an invoice.
- If anyone has any questions or ideas on additional fundraising opportunities, please reach out to a Council member, Pastor Andi. We are open to discussing all ideas.
