### From the Desk of Pastor Andi

November, 2023

What are you afraid of? Some of the things that scare us the most are kind of funny. My youngest won't use the bathroom if she sees a spider in there and it hasn't been removed. She'll come all the way downstairs and I'll ask, 'why aren't you using your bathroom?' When she responds with, 'I saw a spider in there this morning and I don't know where it went,' I usually just shake my head. She knows it is ridiculous. But it is easier for her to walk downstairs than to meet the illogical fear that comes from a teeny tiny spider head on.

Fear can be a good thing. Scripture tells us that fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. Fear of getting in trouble has kept a great many of us from doing things we shouldn't. Fear can keep us from doing things that can harm us and therefore the fear of bodily harm has kept us safe. Deeply woven into our fabric is a 'fight or flight' trigger and sometimes survival depends on us listening and choosing flight.

But fear can also keep us from doing good things. Fear can immobilize us. Fear of failure and general self-doubt can convince us to not even try. And when we don't try, we cannot succeed. Hockey great Wayne Gretzky famously said, 'You miss 100% of the shots you don't take'. Fear can cause us to close ourselves off from others. The fear of getting hurt, emotionally or physically, can move us toward isolation. I have seen this with people who have been deeply hurt in a relationship when a person leaves them (either by choice or through death) or cheats on them. Afraid to be hurt again, they do not risk themselves again in another relationship. Fear motivated deep isolation during our pandemic, and some were never able to get back into the greater community for fear of physical harm.

Like so many things in this world, fear is an important part of life and living. It is useful in the right time and place. It is destructive in the wrong time and intensity. That is why the bible encourages us time and time again to not be bound and limited by fear. We serve a God of unlimited power. We are equipped to do all that we are called to do. We need to take the shots, understanding that we will miss sometimes. The challenge we have—indeed the challenge we have always had—is reigning in our fear so that the Spirit can do its work in us, through us and around us. We need to get out of our own way so that we can succeed. Simply put, we need to fully trust in our God.

### **Treasurer's Nook**

It seems the weather changed overnight going from nice, sunny and warm to cold, windy and drabby. As I sit looking out the window at the cloudy and overcast weather, I am still reminded of all the beauty around with the colorful leaves and the blessings to be inside a warm home.

We continue to struggle to meet our monthly financial needs ending the month with a negative cash flow of (-\$4,349) and resulting in a year-to-date cashflow of negative (-\$8,072). We also have the upcoming sidewalk costs that we are anticipating to be approx. \$13,000 that we need to be aware of and will impact the cash reserves. Overall, we are still doing okay but we all need to be aware of our situation.

Thank you to everyone that supports us through your regular giving, various fund raisers, giving of your time and talents and ongoing prayers. We are a blessed congregation and it's sometimes easy to forget this as we get caught up in the small details.

#### Church Council Meeting Highlights October 10, 2023

Meeting called to order by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

**President's Report:** Firehouse Subs - A little weird, but we'll see how it turned out—15% or 20%?. Kwik trip - cards being ordered in September got 20 cards, \$400 profit. Ordering again soon! Vandewalles fundraiser in November and December—ordered 80 candy bars: 1 bar for \$2, or 2 for \$3. Ron Golliher asked if he needed permission to do a fall clean-up. No vote necessary.

Secretary's Report: Accepted as printed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Reviewed September financial reports. We had a negative cash flow of -\$4,348.93 with a negative YTD of -\$8,071.51. Alliant Energy stock was -\$1.72 (3.43%) this month, with a YTD of -\$6.76 (12.24%). The majority of expenses for the month were Employee Pension and Health Insurance, quarterly taxes, Operation Not Alone, Church Windows Support and WPS. Treasurer's report accepted. Pastor's Report: General: We are aware of some sound issues and are looking to fix them. My mic has a short in the wire that connects the headset to the transmitter and I have ordered a new one. Last Month: Zach did a great job leading worship while I was away. I have had 5 funerals since our last meeting, EUCC members Jim Kraemer September 28, Nancy Wolf October 5 and Dorothy Simons October 8 and non-members Joan Quinn September 16 and Beverly Rothenbach September 26. This Month: We have 2 baptisms in October. Weston Jeffrey Winters (Devin and Joelle Winter) on October 15 and Blake Allan Butzen (Mack and Melissa Butzen) on October 22. October 22 is our Trunks for Treats date. Sunday School to follow. It is also Soup2Go pick up. That will take place in the kitchen/fellowship area. Susan Fuchs of Operation Not Alone would like to use the fellowship hall October 29 to assemble Cheer and Care packages. The Cheer packages go out so veterans can receive them by November 11 and the Care Packages go out around Christmas.

Folks are invited to come down and help. For the Future: We are hoping to reserve the Oshkosh West Madrigals again this year.

Vice President's Report: 2 deacon positions open. Earl Dorst said he'd finish 1 unexpired term. Continue asking around for anyone interested.

We aren't sure giving keys to anyone wanting to clean is a good precedent to set. Pastor was given gifts for Pastor Appreciation Month.
