### **Treasurer's Nook**

After reporting our September results and our growing negative cash flow, we ended October with strong monthly giving's that helped us to reduce our year-to-date cash flow deficit to a negative (-\$1,026). While this is good news, we are expecting to receive the sidewalk replacement bill soon that we need to pay. While the actual cost is not yet known, we anticipate the cost to be approximately \$13,000. At this time, we have received \$950 to help pay for this expense. If you would like to donate to this need, please mark your donation with a note for the sidewalk fund or reach out to Lori.

As we enter December, the final month of 2023, we need to take time to reflect on the many blessings we have received as a congregation during this past year. We are fortunate to have members that give of their time, talents and treasures, all of which continue to make a difference for us.

# **Food Pantry**

Our numbers are steadily increasing every day. With the weather getting colder and the heating bills getting higher, along with the holidays, those in need are finding it harder to make ends meet. We started out the month of January serving 60 families. 116 adults and 82 children were helped. 9 months later in October, we served 86 families. 163 adults and 130 children were helped. We had 14 new families in October alone. The need is definitely greater, which means our shelves are getting emptied a lot faster.

### **Church Council**

Church Council Meeting Highlights November 14, 2023

Meeting called to order by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

**President's Report:** We got in the Firehouse Subs check - \$165.00. Vandewalle Candy is here as well.

Secretary's Report: There were a couple of typos, which were fixed. Minutes were accepted as corrected.

**Treasurer's Report:** Reviewed October financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$7,045.79 with a negative YTD of \$1,025.71. Alliant Energy stock was +\$0.34 (0.70%), this month, with a YTD of -\$6.42 (11.63%). Majority of expenses for the month were Employees' Pension & Andi's Health Insurance, Workers Comp, Church Insurance, OCWM monthly payment, Final half of 2023 Association Dues, 3rd Qtr Fed & SS Payroll Taxes and WPS. Report was accepted as printed. Food pantry to offset costs of operation in the amount of \$2000. Allocation was approved. 2024 OCWM will be set at \$18500, same as in 2023.

**Pastor's Report:** My mic had a short in the wire that connects the headset to the transmitter, and I have replaced it. I have one headset that is for me and one that is for guest preachers. I have been asked to join a conference 'Think Tank' to discuss the role of associations as we move forward. Recruiting volunteers and funding associations is increasingly challenging in this time of declining membership. Our conversations will revolve around 'associating' in both regional and non-geographical ways, and then developing a strategy, timetable, governance changes and ecclesiastical adjustments, and whatever else is needed to implement the vision. These will be 1-2 hr. meetings that take place once a month for the next 5-6 months. Our first meeting is Thursday, November 16.

Last Month: We had 2 baptisms in October. Weston Jeffrey Winters (Devin and Joelle Winter) on October 15 and Blake Allan Butzen (Mack and Melissa Butzen) on October 22. Susan Fuchs of Operation Not Alone assembled Cheer and Care packages on October 29. Leanne Monroe and Carolyn Rukas helped with the process. Trunks for Treats went well, but it seemed like there were fewer kids.
