From the Desk of Pastor Andi

JANUARY 2024

I was reading over some old newsletter the other day. I came across my newsletter article for January 2018 and was reminded that was the year my trusted van hit 100,000 miles. Funny thing, just last week I watched her hit 200,000 miles. I anxiously darted my eyes from the odometer to the road over and over until I saw the mileage change. And then I patted the dash and told her she is doing a great job. Maybe in 2030 we will hit 300,000 miles together!

Some things just feel significant. The first day of January marks the beginning of a new year. Yet it doesn't seem that much different than the days that were before or the days that follow. Its significance come from the emphasis we place on it. For some of us, it offers a place to make real change—New Year: New Me. It offers us a place to start some sort of improvement in our life.

I don't usually make New Year's resolutions, but I embrace the reasoning behind it. Taking a moment to evaluate our lives, gauge our joy, and plan for improvement is a wonderful and healthy thing to do. In fact, I think everyone should be doing it! Change is hard and we are usually more inclined to stay in our current situation rather than commit to the work of bringing about change. But when we decide to actively pursue joy, our lives change.

I don't know what changes you are needing to make in your life. Heck—I am not always sure about the changes I need to make in my own life! But I know that when we choose to follow where joy leads us, our lives improve exponentially.

But here is the rub—we can't evaluate our lives, gauge our joy, and plan for improvement just one day out of the year. This is something I am going to encourage you to do every day. The reason so many of these sweeping New Year's Resolutions fail is because we see it as an all or nothing kind of thing. Then if we fail in one part, we have failed as a whole. This year, might I suggest we try a new approach. Let's resolve each start of our day to embrace joy and be the best version of ourselves we can be, implementing slight changes that contribute to a greater whole. And at the end of the day, set aside time to take stock of your day. If it has been a good day, offer prayers of thanksgiving to God. If it's not been the best of days, offer prayers of thanksgiving to God, the gift of grace to yourself, and the resolve to be better tomorrow.

As we move into 2024, we need to remember the estimated \$13,000 sidewalk bill we should be receiving very soon. At the end of November, we have raised \$950 towards this debt.

Church Council Meeting December 12, 2023

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: Jeff Stark put together some documents relating to the energy stock, welcome to Laurie and Earl Dorst as new deacons. Earl is filling an unfinished term.

Secretary's Report: Many small, mostly grammatical/spelling mistakes from the last minutes, which had been pointed out and corrected. Report accepted as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed November financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$686.57 with a negative YTD of \$339.14. Alliant Energy stock was +\$1.78 (3.65%), this month, with a YTD of -\$4.64 (8.40%). Majority of expenses for the month were Employees Pension & Andi's Health Insurance, 4th Qtr Fed & SS Payroll Taxes, Envelopes, WPS, and City of Oshkosh – Water. Kim's extra comments: Quilters Group gave \$1,200 for building use, the internal transfer for food pantry (to offset energy expenses) will happen in December. Changes to Balance Sheet - Vanco, Youth Group, Carpet Fund, Vacant Lot Fund, Designated Missions, Choir Fund all removed. Report accepted.

Pastor's Report: General: We received a check from Pittsville UCC (my home church). They have been using my sermons from 2017 in their worship services. I don't know how long this will go on, but I suspect it will be a while. Our Thursday evening services are on hold the months of December and January. We will resume those services on February 1. February 14 is Ash Wednesday (happy Valentine's Day) and we will have our usual Wednesday Lenten Services. I will need to consider the 9:00 services as they were very sparsely attended. I am also looking at Lenten Studies to offer. Those were better attended over the lunch hour than in the evening. Feedback is always appreciated. I will be tabling plans for a sabbatical. I am more inclined to enter a time of personal and professional discernment. Last Month: I officiated at 2 funerals in November: Arlyss Luft on November 25 and Bill Gee on November 27. I

was the legal officiant at the November 22 wedding of Cole Yoder and Katie Aman. After a bit of a hiatus from conference work, I have participated in 2 Conference Zoom meetings (November 16 and December 7) as we explore the role of Associations moving forward in the Wisconsin Conference. Lack of volunteers and rising costs have pushed us to re-examine the way we govern and minister together. A little background: the Wisconsin Conference is divided into four associations. The associations provide direct connections to the congregations in the state and help nurture their ministers.

Pastor's Report Continued: The Associations are charged with promoting Christian fellowship among its local church members, providing leadership, training, and support for shared ministries of its local churches, expressing concern for the welfare of local churches, their ministers, and members, and helping churches and pastors in difficult situations such as crisis or misconduct on the part of pastor or parishioners. Authorization for Ministry and Standing is vested in the Associations. It is the Northeast Association Division of Church and Ministry that authorizes, oversees, and supports our pastors, churches, and commissioned ministers. This committee examines candidates for ordination and recommends whether or not they should be ordained, authorizes and recognizes persons as ministers, and authorizes disciplinary action against ministers. As we move forward, I think people are most concerned with centralizing these authorization for ministry tasks. This Month: A quick reminder that December 17 the OWHS Madrigals will sing at 8:45. The Sunday School Program will follow.

Christmas Eve services will be at 3:00 and 5:00. The choir will be singing at the 3:00 service. This will also be the service that is live streamed.

Vice President's Report: Dan said the new member's keys and codes are a WIP. Update the digital key log that Lori has with the information added to the physical one more regularly.

Deacon's Report: White paraments cleaning done, Rene says the green should be next. Small sacristy fridge died, one was donated to replace it.

Trustee's Report: Craig: Blue Diamond Carpet, got some estimates (\$760 for all areas, split into 4 areas). Dry carpet cleaning supplies and waxing supplies, the trustees will look into what we have as well as if the supplies are worth keeping/using or if they should be thrown out. Security Lubke is coming in for some roof repair estimates on December 13. Tom: Heater motor broken for back south park entrance, estimated ~\$75 for the replacement part. Switching lights to LED, the bulbs are getting harder to find and retrofitting them to LED would be better for the long term as well as for energy. Estimated <\$500 for the lights.
