From the Desk of Pastor Andi

FEBRUARY 2024

Ash Wednesday, as we all know, marks the beginning of Lent. This year it falls on February 14, Valentine's Day. And because of this overlap, I headed to Wikipedia to get a better understanding of the history of the Feast of Saint Valentine. Long story short, a religious feast set aside to celebrate martyrs morphed into something different through legends, folk stories, maybe a little misunderstanding, and commercialism. Still a sweet little 'holiday' to show love to the people precious to you, in my humble opinion.

All of it got me thinking about how we often don't fully understand the origins of the traditions we follow. So much of what we do in the church is rooted in ancient ways of thinking and believing. In the Hebrew Scriptures ashes were used for two purposes—as a sign of humility and mortality and as a sign of sorrow and repentance for our sins. Receiving ashes on our heads is a reminder of our mortality and a sign of sorrow for our sins.

This mark of ashes on our foreheads is a mighty sign. It reminds us that we are mere mortals. The second creation story of Genesis reminds us that God formed Adam out of the dust and breathed life into him. From the dust we were created; to dust we shall return—ashes to ashes, dust to dust. But these dusty humans are greatly loved by the Creator! That ashen cross that is supposed to be and apology letter to God, expressing how sorry we are for the hurt we have caused, is also a sign of the great love we experience by knowing our Jesus. The holy water cross that marked our foreheads at our baptism is redrawn in ash every Ash Wednesday. And so, this is a sacred and special time for me. As you come forward and receive that ash, I can look at you and (hopefully) remind you of how precious you are, how loved you are, and how blessed we are to be in this place.

I hope your Lenten season is one that draws you closer to God and one another as we work together as the Body of Christ.


