From the Desk of Pastor Andi

May 2024

Growing up, my dad was able to fix most things around the house. I continue to be amazed by those people who can take things apart and put them back together. Oh—I am pretty good at getting it taken apart, but the ‘putting it back together’ part is hit or miss. Am I the only one who grimaces at the end when there are parts and pieces left over? Most of the time I just hope for the best and pray it works OK without that piece.

I feel like we are at that place here at Emmanuel. We are trying to keep things running and make things work, but pieces are missing. The list of needed volunteers continues to grow. Soon, the few individuals who have been doing a great deal of the work will need a rest. Without others to step up and fill the void, the hoping and praying will increase as we worry things will fall apart before our eyes.

So, I am going to share a few things with you—what is needed and why it is important.

1. Our Christian Education program (Sunday School) needs teachers. Why is this program important? Besides fostering a connection between our kids and the church, it fills a gap in learning. We don't spend a lot of time in our homes teaching about the stories of Jesus and why they are important. Without a basic foundation, it is easy for kids to grow into young adults that see no need for the church. Studies have shown that those kids who claim to have a faith life have lower instances of drug use, self-harm, and suicide. Parents can't *always* be with their kids. Knowing Jesus and God allows them to understand there is something bigger than them when life gets to be overwhelming—something or someone that works with them and for them so they can succeed. We offer Sunday School only twice a month and our classes have too large an age gap. But without people willing to step up and help grow the church, this program is sputtering. Find a friend and teach even once or twice a month. Without volunteers, we are doing a grave disservice to our kids and young families. This will hinder our growth in the long run. If you'd like to know more about this, let me or Kay Lund (Sunday School Superintendent) know. We can talk about the number of diverse ways you can help this vital ministry.
2. Visitation Ministry. Why is this important? So many of our people serve Emmanuel their whole lives. When the time comes that they can no longer get to church, they feel forgotten. While I will continue to do communion visits, it would be so wonderful for folks to get a visit from others in the congregation. I know this can be something people are reluctant to do because it is not always a part of our tradition. You might even feel a bit uncomfortable reaching out for the first time. But if you even have the slightest interest, let me know. I would love to have a conversation with you about ways to reach out and start a conversation, as well as identifying who you would like to visit. This is an incredibly rewarding ministry to be a part of—both for the person you are visiting and for you!

3. Our Video/Media Ministry. Why is this program important? Livestreaming our services means those who are unable to be at church can still worship remotely. This means more than just being able to take church with you on vacation or when you have to miss a Sunday. Those who are 'shut-in' their homes or an assisted living facility can still be a part of worship. Having this connection to the church you love is vital to a number of people. As for those who attend worship in person, we have become quite accustomed to having the screen and it means we can pull from a wide variety of resources rather than being tied to the hymnals in the pew. Emmanuel livestreams around 62 services a year and uses the screen in worship for around 106 services. We currently have 3 people who know how to livestream and 5 people who have signed up to run the projector in the last couple of months. While neither of these tasks are all that difficult, I know it may seem intimidating. Don't let that keep you from at least seeing what it is all about. You don't have to be 'technologically savvy' (trust me—I have figured it out and I still need help from my kids with my phone and computer at times!) If you would like to know more about this, let me know. I can show you some things, or pair you up with someone who can show you what it's all about and sit with you the first few times you do it in worship.

4. Cleaning. Why is this important? None of us want to live in squalor! We are quite proud of our building—not in a sinful way, but as a testimony to the history of the church. People have and do work hard to keep the building and grounds maintained and clean. As finances tightened and our custodians retired, we opted to clean ourselves rather than take on the cost of hiring someone else. But it is a big job! Fortunately, our cleaning team has broken the job of cleaning the church into many small tasks. You can pick a task and do it at your convenience (a confirmation parent cleans while their child is in class, for instance). In the future we might again find ourselves in a place where we can hire this job out, though that comes with its own challenges and worries. But for right now, the more people who will do this and that around the church, the better we will be. There is a sign-up sheet online if you are interested. If you would like more information, let me know. I will pair you up with someone and you can see what it is all about. This is by no means an exhaustive list—but my space is limited! Emmanuel is an exceptional faith community. It has taken effort on the part of our forefathers and foremothers, and we are tasked with continuing to build up this church. Please prayerfully consider how you will continue to grow this church!

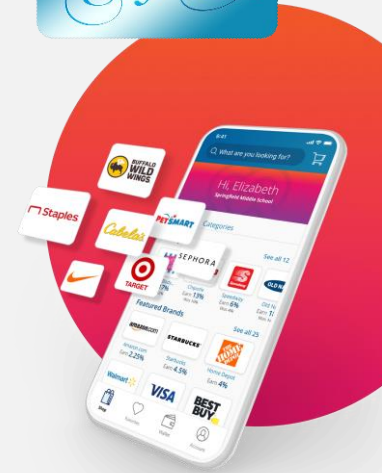
RAISERIGHT GIFT CARD ORDERS ARE DUE ON SUNDAY, MAY 5TH

Church Council Meeting Highlights April 9, 2024

Meeting called to order by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: There was an issue with the phone system, but it was a line issue, so it was fixed with no cost. Vandewalles sale made \$317. Alarm system has had "Comm Failure", working to get that fixed.

Dine and Donate ideas: Perkins and Five Guys.

Secretary's Report: A few minor corrections to the minutes, the minutes were accepted as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed March financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$10,483.19 with a positive YTD of \$6,051.44. Several members gave their yearly contribution this month. Alliant Energy stock was +\$2.65 (5.55%), this month, with a YTD of - \$0.90 (1.75%). Majority of expenses for the month were Emp Pension & Andi's Health Ins, GuideOne - Church Insurance/Workers Comp, WPS - Gas & Electric, 1st Qtr. 2024 Fed & SS Payroll Taxes, Cintas Fire Extinguisher Maintenance and Barthels Farms - Feb snow removal. Kim went through the effort of reorganizing and adding more info to her monthly report, which is very appreciated. Thank you Kim! Report was accepted as printed.

Pastor's Report: General: I will be looking at laptops in the next weeks. I would like to plan a time after worship some Sunday, or on another day, to allow people to explore the needs we have with the media, ushering, cleaning, teaching Sunday School and so on. When do all of you think might be a good time for that? Last Month: I officiated the funeral of Don Wolter March 15. Baptism for Charlotte Lubenow, daughter of Kayla Lubenow and Alejandro Zevallos was March 17. I was pleased with the Holy Week services on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. I thought they were relatively well attended. Early Easter service attendance was quite sparse. Lenten services/Bible Study are completed. While attendance at the Bible Study wasn't bad, the weekly Lenten Services were not well attended. Ash Wednesday and Holy Week services were good, but the weekly Wednesday services were not. This Month: I should finish my Easter visits this week. Mary's 49th Anniversary at EUCC is this month. Northeast Association Annual Meeting is April 20 at Daycholah Center from 9:00am to 2:00pm.
