From the Desk of Pastor Andi

August 2024

While Jesus never said, "kill em with kindness," or "Don't let the haters get you down" he did teach such models of behavior.

In this crazy, and sometimes hateful 'me first' world, we sometimes get so bombarded by the voices of the world that the teachings of Jesus get drowned out. While there is no way for me to test this theory, I believe that If a "new prophet' came preaching the ideals set forth by Jesus, he would be instantly rejected by the power structures of this world.

In the gospel of Luke, Jesus instructed us to 'Love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return, and your reward will be great,' In Matthew, he says, "but I say to you who here comma love your enemies comma do good to those who hate you comma bless those who curse you comma pray for those who abuse you." In general, Jesus tells us that whatever we wish that others would do to and for you, do also for and to them.

So, if you are like me, and a little unsettled and frustrated (maybe even fatigued and overwhelmed) about how people are behaving these days, it makes sense! They are openly violating the ideals of Jesus Christ and deep within us we know it. We feel in our very spirits that it isn't right. But we aren't sure what we can do about it.

In Paul's letter to the Ephesians he writes, 'Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put always from you, along with all malice. "These behaviors are from the old self – the person we were before we got to know Jesus. But once we let Jesus into our lives, our behavior changes (most of the time. We still revert to our old ways now and then. That is why we continue to depend on the gift of grace.) Paul outlines the new self, the one that walks with Jesus. The new person we are in Christ chooses to 'Be kind to one another, tender hearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. Therefore, be imitators of God, as beloved children.'

And so really, we try to be the people Jesus calls us to be. There's a lot going on in this world. And sometimes it feels like too much. We know things have to change, but we don't know how to change them. We know things aren't moving in the right direction, but we don't know how to turn in the direction we need to be traveling. In these times, Jesus continues to instruct us to simply continue to be the people we were created to be. Don't let the negativity keep you from being brothers and sisters in Christ. When the haters come, when the negativity surrounds you, simply shake the dust from your sandals and continue on. Continue following Christ. Continue to walk in kindness. Continuing to be disciples.

This summer has been one of rain, rain and more rain. While I haven't had to water my garden much, the weds have also liked all the water and are growing quickly too.

We have done a better job this year of keeping our income and expenses consistent, ending the first half of the year with a year-to-date deficit of (\$4,985). Last year at the end of June, we had a very large deficit of (\$26,289) which we had to try to overcome.

We have received our sidewalk invoice which totals \$12,590.94. We have \$6,690 available leaving us \$5,940.94 remaining to raise by November 1.

Once again this year, we all have the opportunity to help raise funds by participating and/or volunteering with the upcoming events including the EAA parking of cars (July 22-28), the Pizza Ranch night our (August 19) and the purchasing of RaiseRight (scrip) cards. Church Council Meeting Highlights June 11, 2024

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: Kim and Mike are hosting the council get together on July 9th, and a sign up for refreshments.

Secretary's Report: Minutes accepted as printed.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed May financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$1,044.63 with a negative YTD of -\$1,239.42. Alliant Energy stock was +\$1.69 (3.39%), this month, with a YTD of +\$0.19 (0.37%). Majority of expenses for the month were Emp Pension & Andi's Health Ins, WPS – Gas & Electric, 2nd Qtr 2024 Fed & SS Payroll Taxes, Facts – Chruch website annual hosting, Accu-Com – Replace Alarm Panel.

Pastor's Report: I purchased a laptop. I am not sure I will be having Link continuously monitor it. A basic antivirus should be sufficient and cheaper. Confirmation was on May 19 and I think it went well. I had my last COP meeting May 21 at Union Church in Green Bay. I am not sure I will be participating in a COP next year as I attend my local Clergy gathering each month. I officiated at a graveside service May 31 for Donald Wolff. This Month: Graduation Recognition was June 2. We recognized 1 college graduate and 4 high school graduates. June 30 is a 5th Sunday so we will be having a Noisy Offering. Just a reminder, I am on vacation July 17-23. I will be out of state and will contact an area minister to be on call in case of emergency. For the Future: EAA Airventure parking is July 22-27. This is a significant fundraiser for us. Last year our portion was about \$18,800. We are not having worship services on July 4. Communion service will be the following week, July 11.
