# From the Desk of Pastor Andi

December 2024

I put my Christmas tree up this past weekend—about 12 days before Thanksgiving. I think this is the earliest I have ever put it up. In years prior I have had people tell me that I really should wait until after Thanksgiving. Uninvited, they would also share when was the ‘right’ time to take the tree down. My snarky response to this unsolicited opinion is usually asking if I should expect their part of the mortgage via check, Zelle or Venmo. I mean, if you want a say in the house rules you need to be paying a part of the mortgage, right?! But all joking aside, the real question is, “Why do you feel a need to share that? Why do you think that the way you do things is the only ‘right’ way?” (Yikes—its that whole toilet paper under or over argument again!!)

Imagine how much more pleasant life would be if we kept our opinions to ourselves unless asked? From where I am sitting, so much of the angst of this present age could be tempered if we simply stayed in our own lane. In the 7<sup>th</sup> chapter of Matthew, Jesus was speaking of judging others when he spoke about seeing the speck in our neighbor’s eye while seemingly not noticing the log in our own eye. Jesus warns, “Do not judge, so that you may not be judged. For the judgment you give will be the judgment you get, and the measure you give will be the measure you get.” But I think life would be so much simpler if we expanded that to include other areas of life. For every unsolicited opinion or piece of advice you give, the same will be offered to you by others who see places in your life where you could improve. Soon you would agree that the worst advice you get is the advice you never asked for.

We are called to be a grace-filled people. Sometimes the discipline of being a disciple that builds others up is learning that there is a time to speak and a time to keep silent. Before you speak this holiday season and beyond, THINK first. Are my words True? Are they Helpful? Are they Inspiring? Are they Necessary? Are my words Kind? T-H-I-N-K before speaking, offering advice, or correcting one another—and you might just save your family holiday celebrations!

Quite honestly, it doesn’t matter to me when others think trees and other decorations should be put up or taken down, or when we should start listening to Christmas music. It doesn’t bother me at all if you want your Pumpkin Spice whatever in August. I don’t mind if you earnestly pray for cooler fall temps when I like the summer. You do you and enjoy the life before you with everything you have. And I will be over here in my lane living my best life and enjoying it as much as I can. If I see you need a helping hand, I will try to offer that before you even have to ask. But as for my opinions about you and your life choices—I will try to keep those to myself unless you ask. Indeed, there is a season for everything and a time for every matter under heaven, just as Ecclesiastes states. And Jesus reminds us, the measure we give is the measure we get, and ultimately, we harvest what we plant.

## Church Council Meeting Highlights, November 13, 2024

Meeting called to order at by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

**President's Report:** Candy Bars sale seems to be going alright; no official number, but last Sunday there were around 90 bars. SouptoGo profit came out to \$1871.

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes were accepted as printed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Reviewed October's reports. We had a negative cash flow of -\$7,872.35 with a positive YTD of \$2,179.08. Alliant Energy stock was - \$0.69 (1.14%), with a YTD +\$8.70 (16.96%) Majority of expenses for the month were City of Oshkosh - Sidewalk, Emp Pension & Andi's Health Ins, 3rd Qtr 2024 Fed & SS Payroll Taxes, VandeWalles and WPS.

Treasurer's report was accepted as printed. Food pantry allocation for 2025 to offset costs of running the pantry was set at \$2400 (\$200/mo). Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) allocation remains the same as last year, \$18500.

**Pastor's Report:** Confirmation is going well. It is a good group of kids. Sunday School Book Drive is going well. I dropped off a check last week that offered a \$5 book to every student at Jefferson. First Congregational has called Julie Eklund, formerly pastor at Redeemer UCC in Sussex. St Paul has called Sandra Crase as a part time interim. She is also a chaplain at Winnebago Mental Health Institute. Last Month: Visitation Ministry training Sunday, October 20 after church and Monday, October 21 at 11:00am went well. I have been asking folks as I visited if they would like some lay visits o and the response has been quite positive. I co-officiated with Kevin Mundell at the funeral of Marilyn Patrick at Our Savior's UCC in Ripon. This Month: Don Hoeft's funeral was here at EUCC on November 10, November 21 is our last Thursday service for the year, November 27 Thanksgiving Eve service, November 30 Decorate for Christmas For the Future: December 1 Hanging of the Greens service for the 1st Sunday of Advent, December 15 the ONHS Madrigals will be providing prelude music at 8:45am, December 22 is the Sunday School Christmas Program and December 24 Christmas Eve services at 3:00 and 5:00

**Vice President's Report:** Linda Stowe, a prospective council member, was invited to this and December's meetings.

**Deacon's Report:** Deb offered to step in as head Deacon.

**Trustee's Report:** The new sign in front of the building has been drawn up, and Tom brought the image to the council. Aside from correcting a typo in the number, the sign looks good to go forward with. The Fall Cleanup went well, thank you to all who helped out! The M&E allocated funds will go towards the new sign as well as a direct donation. The lights for the Sanctuary/Narthex are good to be ordered! M&E allocated monies will go toward that cost as well.

**Church Council Meeting Highlights, November 13, 2024** *Continued...*

**Old Business:** For the new VOIP phone system, looking at getting more information about going with Jeff Pullman-Becker to install the system, which would then be run through VOIP.MS. More information to be provided later, with the hope being early next year the installation process can start.

**New Business:** Budget Discussion: Salary Increase based on the CPI was 2.4406%, which was increased to both Andi's salary and housing allowance but all directed into her salary. Prospective custodian budget, in case one is hired, was included. Health Insurance portion of the budget it still TBD, with Andi and Kim looking at new health insurance plans. Paastor Andi's current health insurance is being looked at and compared to other marketplace options to see if there's a way to decrease how much is spent on it. More information between plans is still being looked at before a decision will be made. If a new plan is given, finding a way to adjust Pastor Andi's salary to reflect no longer providing health insurance through an employer while keeping government stipend will also need to be brainstormed.

The M&E gave their Annual Income Distribution Recommendation to be voted on by the council. Council approved the allocation and it will be sent to the Annual Meeting for a congregational vote.

Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

Next meeting is on December 10, 2024 at 6:30 p.m.
