As I write this article, we are in the most hustle-y and bustle-y part of the Advent season—just 8 days before Christmas. Lines are long, parking spaces are scarce, and people are stressed. It is so easy in the midst of all the preparation to forget why we're doing this. Now by the time you have this newsletter in your hands it's either going to be right before Christmas or after Christmas. These crazy days of advent where we run around trying to make sure everything is perfect (spoiler alert--it's not gonna be perfect) we are supposed to be preparing ourselves for the coming of Christ. It's not so much about who we are when we welcome the baby Jesus on Christmas morning, it's about who we are when we welcome the returning Christ in the days to come. When Jesus returns, and he will return, what will he find? What will he see when he looks deep inside each of us?

Those are the questions I take into this new year. I think that if we're honest with ourselves, few of us expect Jesus to return within our lifetime. And I think that view of Christ return has changed the way we live our daily lives. Because we no longer live our lives as if tomorrow Jesus could return, we fool ourselves into thinking that we have all the time in the world. (Here's another spoiler alert--we don't have all the time in the world!) Now I don't know when Jesus is going to return, no one knows that but God. But I do know it's important for us to start looking at each day as an opportunity to do the ministry we're called to do. When we begin to see the risen Christ in the faces of the people around us, we begin to treat the people around us differently. When Jesus returns, and he will return, what will he find? What will he see when he looks deep inside each of us?

Again, I don't know when he'll return. And I don't know what he'll look like when he returns. After all, no one expected the Messiah to come to us in a helpless little infant. God bursts into our lives in amazing and confusing ways. I happen to think, for what it's worth, that when Jesus visits us again it will not be as someone who is privileged, or powerful, or wealthy. I believe Jesus will return as someone who is chronically overlooked or oppressed or trampled on. And if indeed Jesus returns as one of the

people that society has pushed to the margins, what will he find? Or maybe even what will she find? Or what will they find? When the Messiah returns and looks deep inside each of us what will our Divine Savior see?

2025 promises to be just as divisive and chaotic and ugly as the years preceding it. And none of that will change until each and every one of us changes. The challenge many of us have is choosing to expect others to begin the demanding work of change. Our reality is that the only thing that we control is ourselves, so if we want change, it needs to begin with me.

So, my gift to you, if you can call it that, is to remind you of St. Francis of Assisi's Prayer for Peace. Consider carrying it closely to your heart as you move into this new year. Blessings to all of you—Pastor Andi

This past month, we sent \$1,500 from the Sunday School Mission project to support the Jefferson School book program which helps to make a difference in these children's lives.

President's Report: Candy Bar - Sold 420 of 600, decided to continue to sell this Sunday and the 22nd. Pizza coupons should be here by the 15th.
