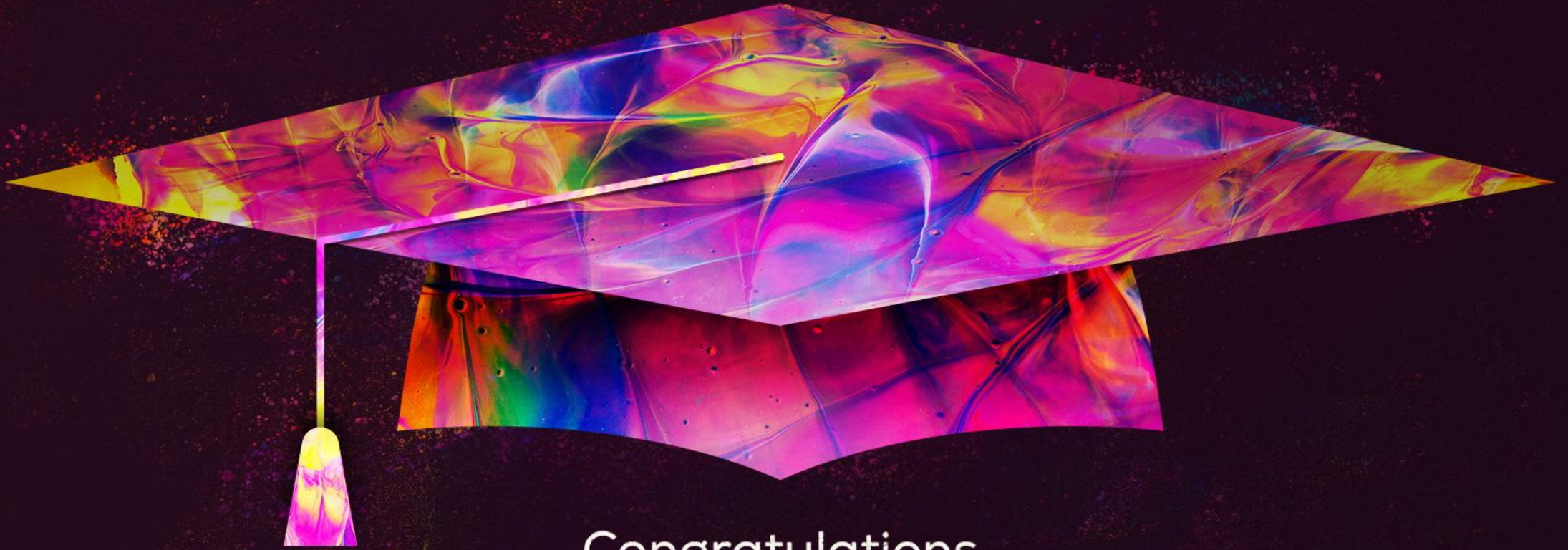

Way back in the time of Moses, after he led the people out of Egypt and across the divinely divided Red Sea, the Israelites found themselves camped out at the foot of Mount Sinai. Moses was spending more and more time up on the mountain in the presence of Yahweh. To the Israelites, he was spending too much time, and they began to get scared. Afraid he wasn't coming back, they went to Aaron and asked him to make some new gods for them—gods that would go before them and lead them out of this wilderness. So, they gathered all the gold from the ears of the people and Aaron formed it into the image of a calf. The people gathered around this golden calf and had one heck of a celebration. Their real God, Yahweh, who had led them out of Egyptian slavery and through the Red Sea was done with them. Moses reasoned with God and God let go of the wrath originally planned. But when Moses saw with his own eyes what the people had done, he, too, was livid! That stupid golden calf: it pulled the people's attention away from what God had done for them. That ridiculous golden calf: formed because people were afraid and wanted something—anything really—to hold on to. That cursed golden calf that caused the people of God to sin a great sin.

You know, it wasn't the golden calf's fault, it was the people's fault. And sadly, we still cling to our own golden calves today. There are all these shiny, expensive things that pull our eyes—and attention—away from what God has called us to do. Precious traditions can push our minds and emotions in a direction God is not calling us to go. A lack of understanding, and an unwillingness to open our minds a little so we can understand, calls us to behave in ways that are not pleasing in the sight of God. And, of course, there is fear. Just as the Israelite's were afraid, we are too. And that fear, stoked by evil, can move us in ways we never imagined. Fear that we won't have enough. Fear that someone is going to get something we didn't get (or need). Fear that our way of life isn't going to be honored. Fear that 'those people' will take over (now, 'those people' can include all sorts of human being created and loved by God, they just don't live life the way we do or worship the way we do or belong here like we do). Fear feeds the worst in us, until one day we are dancing around a fire in front of an altar holding a golden calf. When the realization hits us that we have sinned a great sin, we will lament and cry aloud, wondering how we got to this place.

I don't know what your golden calf might be. But I sure hope you have the faith and the strength to figure that out. If we don't, that great sin will not only weigh down our souls, it might wreck lives in the process. So, I suggest you keep the gold in your ears and rest your spirits in the call to love. We are still going to want shiny and expensive things. Just make sure your desire to have more doesn't come at the cost of someone else having just the basics. We are still going to cling to our traditions and the comfortable things in life that offer us a safe space. Just make sure your comforting traditions doesn't mean others can't find theirs in new ways. We are not always going to understand the reasoning of these other generations. That has been a reality since the beginning of time. We can simultaneously respect another's values, ideas and lifestyles while feeling ours are best for us. Sin occurs when we try to force others to accept our ways. And fear will always be a part of our lives. But faith in our God—Creator, Christ and Spirit—holds that fear at bay. When we lose trust in God to continue to be our God, we turn to our golden calf that tells us it is ok to treat others with hate, disdain, scorn, and apathy. And how we treat one another matters. It matters so much that in the hours before Jesus died on the cross, he told us that if we remember nothing else, remember this new commandment—love one another.

Yeah—keep that gold in your ears and rest your spirits in the call to love. Amen.

Food Pantry Update...

During the month of April, we served 105 families. 14 were new to our pantry. We served 186 adults and 133 children. 11,025 pounds of food was distributed.

In May we started our additional shift on Wednesday afternoons. We are still in need of people to volunteer to help with this shift. Calls would need to be answered between 3:00pm and 4:30pm with food distribution from 4:30-5:00pm. We are also in need of volunteers to cover our other shifts as well. We need someone to answer the phones and help with the distribution of food on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings. Phones are answered from 8:00-9:30am with distribution from 9:30-10am. We currently have an amazing group of volunteers who have agreed to fill in where they are needed, however, with people having surgery, or going on vacation we are depending on them to work more than one day a week. If we had more volunteers, you wouldn't have to work every week. Please prayerfully consider helping us provide for those in need in our community.
