Pastor Andi's Message

February 2026

For the first time in a very long time, I had all my Christmas decorations down in the beginning of January. In all honesty, I don't put a whole lot up besides a tree, stockings and a few things here and there. But it is rare that I take it down before the end of January. There is no real reason other than I had the time and the inclination. So, Christmas at the Wolf house is all packed away. Now we are following the star and trying to remain open to the epiphanies God sends.

We are now a few weeks into this new year, and I have no idea what lies up around the bend. We all know there is something up there, but we just can't make out what, exactly, it is. Is it good? Is it a challenge we didn't anticipate? Who knows!?! The funny thing is that sometimes that 'not knowing' brings anxiety and other times hopeful anticipation. And the way the 'not knowing' affects us has more to do with us than the actual circumstances around us. This is one reality in life that always amazes me. We have more control over some things than we ever imagined but focus on trying to control the things that were never ours to control!

We have a certain amount of control over our own thoughts, feelings and responses. We don't have control over external circumstances...or others. And yet we consistently try to change others rather than work on ourselves. Strange... Or is it? Trying to change the things about ourselves that need some work is, well, work! We don't want to change the way we eat or how much we exercise. We don't want to be challenged to see the world differently or attempt to understand people who think differently than we do. That takes a lot of effort. We are happy to talk about obedience and faithful discipline as it relates to others' walk with Jesus. But when it comes to us and the ways we aren't keeping the commands then we are quick to offer excuses and justifications for our behavior.

I will always remember my ethics professor reminding us that just because our behavior falls within the parameters of man's law, and just because our acts might be justified by the circumstances around us, does not make them right with God. Bad behavior we have justified to other humans is not bad behavior that has been forgiven by God. I have chewed on that lesson for over 30 years. This Lent I invite you to walk a path of obedience and discipline. Not a path that simply denies us the things we enjoy, but one that dives deeper into why we are called to be obedient. I invite you to pray often and listen intently. Open your heart and your mind. God's revelations only come to those open to seeing, hearing or experiencing the Divine. Let's make an effort to be open to the urging of the Spirit, even if the message is a challenge to hear. Actually, let's be open to the urging of the spirit *especially* if it's a challenge to hear. For God's ways and thoughts are not always our ways and thoughts. So, if the message you hear sounds exactly like you and agrees with you all the time, you probably aren't hearing God clearly. The obedience of a disciple calls us to step back from our own perspective so we can begin to see God's. That, my friends, calls for strength and courage. But these steps we begin to take ⁱⁿ Lent can lead and change us for a lifetime.



Church Council Meeting, December 9, 2025

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: 68 Candy Bars left. Thank you, Linda Stowe for your time on the council! And welcome to Leanne Bloedow. Council discussed whether or not we should get roller blinds to replace the current lower narthex blinds. Council will get some samples of different blinds from Lowe's to look at self-install. Leanne gave a Contact sheet/Term sheet update.

Secretary's Report: Included Leanne B. in the minutes, and fixed some small typos. Minutes were accepted as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed November financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of 3,380.17 with a negative YTD of -6,962.75. Alliant Energy stock was +\$2.65 this month. Majority of expenses for the month were Payroll taxes for 4th quarter, WPS and Andi's Health Ins/Pension. Treasurer's Report was accepted as printed.

Pastor's Report: General: I have Connie Whittaker's evaluation completed. The Advent Bible Study is going well. We finished our third session. Next Tuesday is our last class of this study. Thanksgiving Eve service went well. Thank you to all who decorated the church for Christmas. We might want to have a better defined plan moving forward. Last Month: November 29 I officiated Lee Burton's funeral. This Month: I participated at the Peace Light ecumenical prayer service at the Jesuit Retreat Center Sunday, December 7. I have brought the light home with me and will bring it to church for the rest of the advent and Christmas season. December 7 we had our monthly Sr. High Youth Meeting. The Oshkosh North Madrigal Singers are scheduled for December 14 at 8:45am. That is also the Sunday School program date.

Christmas Eve Services will be at 3:00 and 5:00, just as they were last year.

Vice President's Report: Key log is being updated.

Deacon's Report: Some differences with how the deacons will deal with consecrated communion wine left after worship –it will be collected to refill travel communion kits.

Trustee's Report: Craig is getting a couple more bids on tuck pointing for proposal at annual meeting from A O Handy - repairs (bid waiting), Top Notch tuck pointing - repairs on east wall and price on needed on whole church (bid waiting), Rock Solid (received last month). Discussed finding something to do with the old fellowship hall chairs in closet.

Old Business: AT&T internet is set up and the speeds are faster. Need to switch from the old WiFi to the new one.

New Business: Donation request - Somebody wants to donate a Shark carpet shampooer. Council approved the donation. Budget discussion pointed out a big increase in insurance. Deb will look into a Tamara's fundraiser. Will order candy bars again for later in the spring. Council approved ordering more Kwik Trip car wash cards.

Good & Welfare: Pizza Ranch 1/26/26 fundraiser-we will need some help!

Pastor's Report: General: This year I am due to complete both Boundary Training and Anti-racism training. I will be taking Boundary Training on January 29 from 9:00a-3:00p and Anti-Racism Training in the spring, April 27, May 11 and 18 from 10:00 to noon. Cost for the two courses is \$185. Last Month: Celebration of Lights seemed to be a success. Thanks to all who collected food at the EAA grounds and those who sorted and put it away. It looked like a lot of food was handled! Next year if the powers that be follow the same protocol, we will have the week after Christmas. Christmas Eve services went well. The first service was well attended and the second service had more people than last year. For the Future: Thursday Services begin Feb 5. Feb 18 is Ash Wednesday.
