Pastor Andi's Message

April 2026

Family game night is a thing in our house. There is no set schedule, but when a few of us are together, we will often play a game together. Last week we played an autopsy forensic mystery game. And I won! I remember the days when I won (or could have won if I wanted) most of the time. It wasn't that I was smarter, but since I had lived so many more years I just knew more 'stuff.' These days my wins are fewer and hard fought.

I don't like losing—I don't think anyone does. And while I did 'throw' a game a number of times, so the kids didn't get too discouraged, I let them lose regularly. It builds character and shows them that things don't always go their way. Learning to lose—and win—graciously, is a significant part of life.

In general, acknowledging that someone might have been better or smarter is important, as is owning up to the mistakes or misjudgments that you made that might have contributed to your defeat. I am not a big fan of people who cannot, or will not, take responsibility for their own mistakes. Only small-minded people cannot admit they were wrong or that someone else was simply better. Sometimes that is just a mighty character flaw: other times it can have major consequences.

As we approach Easter, we will spend a little time with Peter. You remember Peter—he was outspoken and confident. When Jesus predicted his death, Peter rebuked him. When Jesus stated that all the disciples would desert him, Peter disagreed. And then he doubled-down, saying, 'Even if everyone else deserts you, I will never desert you.' (Matthew 26:33) We all know how that turned out. Peter does, in fact, desert him out of fear. Then he turns back to follow at a distance to keep an eye on what is going on. While there he is asked three different times if he knows Jesus. He denies knowing him all three times. Every. Single. Time. Even though Jesus had warned him of this very scenario, Peter fails.

But for Peter there is a moment of realization. Caught up in the moment he is afraid of being arrested so he denies knowing his Lord. Caught up in the moment, he says things he wishes he could take back. He has the opportunity right away to 'right' his initial denial but does not take it. He sticks with the lie; he carries out the denial. Deny, deny, deny.

Pastor Andi's Message

Deep down he has to know this is wrong, but self-preservation wins out over being faithful. Deep down Peter has to know what he is saying is bad, but once he speaks the denial, he sticks with it. Caught up in the moment...but something (a rooster crowing) snaps him back to reality—to what he has just done. Guilt and shame wash over him, and he breaks down, weeping at what he has done.

Lent, I believe, is about listening for the rooster crowing. It is about taking a step back and seeing our actions and words for what they are. It is being repentant and acknowledging that our words and actions have hurt others, whether we intended it or not. But Easter... Easter is about something far greater than our sin. Easter is about grace and mercy delivered in love. Easter means because the tomb is empty our hearts are filled. The joy of the empty tomb requires us to dig deep and acknowledge our sin—those times we said or did something we should not have as well as the times we did not say or do something we know we should have. In those moments, we can learn, we can grow, and we build character and faith.

I hope you all will join me at the empty tomb, but I pray also that you will join me in the hard work of remembering the passion of Holy Week as well. Together we can marvel at the grace and mercy delivered to each of us, and all of us, in the love of our God. Amen.

We all have our courtyards. Use this Lenten journey to get prepared for yours.

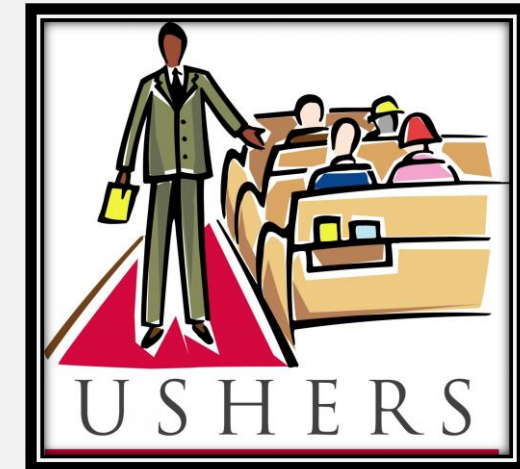

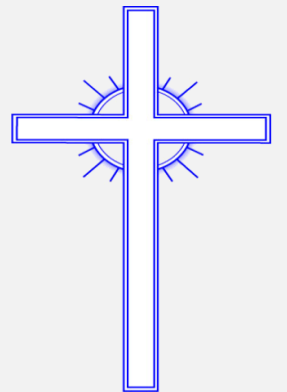

Highlighted Church Council Meeting Minutes March 10, 2026

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: Culver's fundraiser is happening Tuesday, April 28. We have sold 114 out of our 600 candy bars so far. Car wash cards - Lori ordered some more. Custodian Replacement: Connie is stepping away from the position due to unforeseen circumstances. Valeria Basler was interested in the position, so council approved motion to offer her the job.

Secretary's Report: A few corrections and the report was accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed February financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of +8,437.82 with a positive YTD of \$4,776.22. Alliant Energy stock was +6.43 this month. Majority of expenses for the month were Payroll taxes, WPS, Andi's Health Insurance/Pension and Bartels Farm Snow Plowing. Treasurer's Report accepted as printed.

Pastor's Report: General: The Lenten book study of "An Unlikely Lent" by Rachel Billups is going well. We have a class of 11. We will meet again next week, March 17, skip the week I am on vacation, and have our last class on March 24. I ordered a new headphone mic. There are funds available to cover the cost (less than \$23.10) in the Memorial Fund, but they would need to be officially requested by the council. I will also be ordering a second backup mic. Mary Rapp's Memorial Gathering on March 15 has been cancelled due to inclement weather. Peter Smith will be providing pulpit supply while I am on vacation. I would like us to form 2 new committees: an Altar Committee and a Fellowship Committee. The Altar Committee would be tasked initially with creating visual pieces for the altar and general worship space. We would start with special services (Easter, Pentecost, Confirmation, World Communion Sunday, Christmas...) and go from there as the members felt inspired. This committee would need to have an eye for decoration and be able to work together. The Fellowship Committee would be tasked with planning a couple of fellowship opportunities each year—think a pancake breakfast and a dinner or something like that. I will ask for volunteers and if no one offers to do the work of planning activities I will just have to guess those things aren't important to the congregation. We have to start having more people involved with the work of the church or we risk being a consumer church where people come not to give and share but to consume what others offer. Those churches don't last long—nor do churches that rely on only a couple of people to do the work of the church. Last Month: I officiated at the funeral of Keith Cory February 20. This Month: Holy Week services are Maundy Thursday @ 7:00 and Good Friday @ 1:00. Easter services will be the same as last year; 7:30 and 9:00. The kids' Easter Egg Hunt will be after the 9:00 service. For the Future: Wisconsin Conference Annual Meeting is April 10-11 at the Green Lake Conference Center. I will be attending and we can have 2 additional delegates.

Old Business: Red Robin is very open with their fundraiser dates, so we are waiting for them to see about other things (like Culver's) first. Lambeau Field had some info on different volunteering opportunities. Jim and Jody will look into it a bit more, but it feels like it won't be a match.

New Business: Deb asked, and the council discussed, reviewing membership rolls. Audit- Last time we did one was April 11, 2024. Council seemed agreeable to getting some people together to do another one this year, setting it for every 2 years. Mary brought forth an opportunity for the musician, Peter Mayer, to play at our church. Council is unsure as to whether a concert would be the best idea at our church as we don't have the planning set in place and decided to encourage another venue is able.

Good & Welfare: Ushers -There is a sign-up genius for this, but we will talk with Lori and see how to best streamline the sign-up process and make sure people know how to.

Meeting adjourned at 7:56 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer.
