Pastor Andi's Message

August 2026

Why are we so interested in the sin of our neighbor? Maybe that is a bit of a rhetorical question. Afterall, I know why we stress other peoples' shortcomings--and it has nothing to do with loving them.

I have spent my share of time in a church that had people who believed they were loving people by pointing out their sin. There was no acceptance, just finger-pointing and headshaking. The premise was, "I love you so much and I want you to go to heaven with me. So here is what you need to do and what you need to change to get there. Afterall, even with grace, Jesus told people to go and sin no more."

Oof. Where do we even begin with that? This is along the lines of 'Love the Sinner; Hate the Sin' (which is NOT biblical, by the way). If Jesus were to say anything close to that I think it would be closer to 'Love. Love yourself. Love your neighbor. Love all of creation. And work on overcoming your own sin.'

Simply put, we don't pass judgement on others to help them or love them or protect them from judgement. We do it because it deflects from the myriad of sins we commit each and every day. It makes us feel better about what we do when we can point at someone else and say, "At least I am not as bad as that person." By the way, that is biblical but Jesus was not impressed.

Look, I don't agree with what everyone else does. The choices some people make sometimes cause me to shake my head. At the same time, I am pretty sure my God does that at me all the time. Probably accompanied by some version of "Oh come on—you know better. Ugh!"

I am partially kidding and partially serious. I am not perfect. I stand in grace because that is the only thing that allows me to stand. And I try to appreciate the grace I receive and offer it to others.

I have never before experienced the deep angst and anger that is rampant today. We are not a people living out of a place of love or grace. Fear and anger have replaced the manna offered by God, and we are consuming more than our fair share. But take heart—I have a fix.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and soul and mind. And love your neighbor as you love yourself. Jesus offered us the gift of grace and sent us to share it. He did not call us to pass judgement on our neighbors. If we leave to God the things that are God and follow the call of Jesus, our very world would change for the better.

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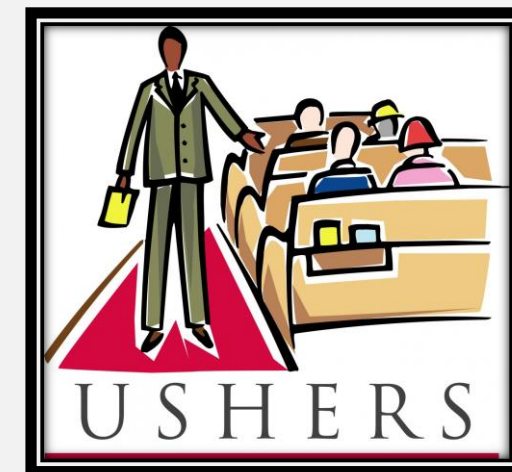

Food Pantry Update...

August 2026

The month of May brought 74 families to our pantry. 139 adults and 126 children were served. We saw 7 new families utilize our pantry in May. We helped 90 families in June. 174 adults and 141 children were served. 17 new families came to our pantry. The summer definitely brought an increase in our pantry numbers.

We are happy to say that we have added fresh produce, milk and eggs to the food items that we hand out. These are part of the government commodities that we receive. However, with the addition of these food items coming in, we have seen a diminish in meat and other staples that we had been receiving previously. We are still in need of non-perishable food items to help fill our shelves. If you see any sales, please pick up some additional items for the pantry. We can't thank you enough for supporting this very important mission of our church.

We continue to depend on our established volunteers to help our food pantry distribute the food to those in need. We would like to thank **Henry Caron** for managing the pantry. Henry seeks out other resources to bring in more food for the pantry. In doing so, he is ordering and picking up food on a weekly basis. Henry is here almost every day working in the pantry. Church Council Meeting Minutes

June 9, 2026

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Leanne. Opening prayer by Pastor Andi.

President's Report: Kwik trip cards are sold out, and their price is increasing from \$20 → \$25 on July 30th. We're buying 10 more cards now and see how well they sell. Lisa Smith recommends we stop purchasing the \$50 Raise Right cards, as they're not purchased as much. Council agrees and also wants to look into getting more help and/or selling the cards after service to make things easier for Lisa.

Secretary's Report: There were some minor typos, but nothing major. Secretary's Report accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed May financial reports. We had a positive cash flow of \$3,812.69 with a positive YTD of \$4,511.26. Alliant Energy stock was -\$1.82 this month. Major changes were payroll taxes for 2nd quarter, WPS, a transfer back to Money Market, Andi's Health Ins/Pension and AO Handy tuckpointing balance. Leanne asks about having a cushion with the money market account for the summer months when things tend to be slower. Treasurer's Report accepted.

Pastor's Report: General: Lori has been in contact with Permar and I believe she has the alarm system under control. All codes should be entered and she has figured out who is in each of our numbered code slots. My Communities of Practice meetings are completed until September. Last Month: We celebrated the Rite of Confirmation May 17 with six young people confirming their baptism. Looking ahead, we have 4 students that will make their confirmation next year (May 23 is next year's confirmation date). We have the potential for six students to join the confirmation program as 7th graders. We will schedule a student and parent meeting in August to get a better idea of who will be participating. I finished my Anti-racism Training on May 18. I will be expected to continue taking a refresher course every 4 years. I officiated at the funeral of Sharon Wilson on May 26. This Month: Lori is on vacation until June 18. Be aware that the office will not be open from 8:00- noon in her absence. Leanne and I will count money and deposit it. No one sent in any info for Graduation Recognition Sunday which was scheduled for June 7. Jim Wilson's funeral is scheduled for Thursday, June 18 here at church. Visitation from 10-noon. Service at noon with lunch to follow. Burial at 2:30.

Vice President's Report: No response from the XRoads fundraiser information.

Deacon's Report: More wine and juice is getting ordered.

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June 9, 2026

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Trustee's Report: Bugs and roundup were sprayed, and the grass will be weed sprayed after the rain is done. Tower and screens: Halfway through the tuck pointing, two of the screens are fixed so far, the aluminum to remake the frames is here. Parking lot striping is going to be done by Noah. The back lot had a request to have someone park one vehicle there during the hunting season. Council thinks that we should have a limit on one car per household if we allow anyone to park there, and possibly make some sort of parking pass for them to put in their car to indicate they can park there. Andi will respond to the request to talk more and hash out more details, but say for now one car will be fine.

Old Business: Internal audit was June 2nd, documentation printed. This was done by Deb Bartel, Rene and Leanne.

New Business: The tower costs came out to \$849.36, but Lori is making sure that everything is tax exempt and the price is correct. The lamplighter costs \$100+ to mail out every month, and we're wondering if there's a way to cut down on that. Currently, we think that keeping a bulk of the lamplighter at church and having more people get it emailed, and for those who don't use email and need one dropped off looking for someone who would be willing to drop one off. Similarly, we think that emailing the office for giving statements would be better than sending those out, so they would be available by request but not constantly supplied. Open positions for council in 2027 are a trustee and the president's position.

Next meeting is on August 11, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.
